As you may recall, I recently shared with you my [letter](#) to the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) asking that the department review its continued link to Lyme treatment guidelines published by the Infectious Disease Society of America (IDSA) in light of a finding by Connecticut Attorney General Richard Blumenthal that several IDSA panel members may hold conflicts of interest.

Today I want to share with you the [response](#) that I received from the Office of **Inspector General** that HHS is currently reviewing this issue.

Please be assured that I will keep you informed as the inspector general releases additional details about the findings of the investigation.

I recognize that this debilitating disease is affecting a growing number of people in northern Virginia, and I am committed to ensuring that those who turn to government Web sites receive the most accurate information possible about Lyme disease.
